RULES AND REGULATIONS

RESPONSIBILITY

All owners, exhibitors, and vendors shall be held responsible for any damages incurred by them, their guests, their horses or employees, to stalls, buildings and other properties on the show grounds and shall be billed accordingly.

ENTRIES

Entry forms must be filled out completely; including all classes or divisions entered, health declaration, signatures, a current coggins, and be accompanied with an open check before a number will be issued. Checks made payable to Alpine Farms.

REFUNDS

Entry Fees will be refunded only with presentation of vet certificate. Stall fees WILL NOT be refunded.

PRIZES

Six ribbons will be offered in every class. Championships will be awarded on the basis of points won in classes throughout the sections: 1st=10pts, 2nd=6pt, 3rd=4pts, 4th=2pts, 5th=1pt, 6th = 1/2pt.

PAYMENT OF FEES

All fees must be paid by the end of the horse show. Anyone leaving the show grounds without full payment of fees will be subject to a \$50 check out fee from competition management. Any mistakes at checkout must be resolved within 24 hours. There will be a \$50.00 returned check charge for any checks returned to the show office by a bank for any reason. No check will be processed through a second time. To retain entries, both entry fees and penalties must be paid by money order, cashier's check or cash.

STABLING

Permanent stalls are available in the north isle. The cost will be \$30.00 per stall per day with limited bedding. A limited number of grooming bays are also available for use. The cost will be \$30.00 per bay per day. Include stall requests when completing entry blank. Payment of stall fees must accompany entry fees and are not refundable. Call Lonnie Underhill (763-473-1361) for stall reservations. Stalls are available on a first come first serve basis. Stalls are available for occupancy Saturday of competition and must be vacated no later than Sunday evening, or two hours after completion of the competition, whichever occurs first.

COGGINS CERTIFICATE and SHOW PARTICIPATION DECLARATION

A current Coggins Certificate must be presented at check in and the "Show Participation Declaration" on the Entry Form must be signed before a number is issued.

SCHOOLING

There will be schooling in the show ring prior to the start of the show from 8AM-9:45AM. In the show ring, exhibitors may hack horses (no jumping) during the designated hours each morning. Schooling fences will be provided for exhibitors in a designated area.

DOGS

Dogs are not permitted. Due to limited space of the indoor barn, we ask that exhibitors leave all dogs at home. This will be strictly enforced.

CONCESIONS

Limited Concessions Available:

ATTIRE

ALL riders must wear protective headgear while riding anywhere on the show grounds. It is compulsory for riders where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fitted and fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. Riders are permitted to wear schooling attire appropriate for riding. Schooling attire will not be penalized.

DESCRIPTION OF COURSES

Hunter fences shall generally simulate obstacles found in the hunting field, such as natural post and rail, brush, stone wall, white board fence, or gate, chicken coop, aiken, hedge, offset oxer, etc.

ANIMAL WELFARE

Any rider or trainer who, in the opinion of the judges or management, uses his/her whip or spurs in an excessive manner will be immediately eliminated from the class where the incident occurred, be suspended from further showing for a twenty-four hour period and will forfeit all entry fees for that class. Further violation by the exhibitor on the same horse or another horse will result in said exhibitor being barred from any further competitions at this series.

MEDICAL WASTE

Due to Federal Regulations, all medical waste must be separated. Receptacles are provided for disposal of hypodermic needles in aisles. Failure to use them will result in a \$100 fine. Please do not mix with manure waste or trash cans.

FEED & BEDDING

Hay and additional Bagged Shavings will be available on the show grounds and may be charged to your horse's account if an open check is left in the office. Bagged shavings may be ordered in advance by contacting the stabling supervisor. Cost for bagged shavings is \$8.00/bag. Pre show orders will only be delivered to pre-paid stalls. The cost of hay (grass only) is \$8.00 per bail. Feed may be purchased at UFC Farm Supply in Maple Plain.

ARENA DIMENSIONS AND FOOTING

Indoor Show Arena: 90' x 170' All weather footing

Indoor Warm Up Arena: 90' x 30' All weather footing

Divisions

All classes are open to juniors, amateurs and professionals. Classes can be re-entered at a cost of \$15.00.

Beginner Poles

Division fee: \$45.00

Classes 1, 2, 3. Courses will be simple and consist of a single pole on the ground between the standards. Cost is \$15.00 per class.

Cross rails

Division fee: \$45.00

Classes 4, 5, 6. Courses will be simple and consist of cross rails with a ground line between the standards. Fence height at 1'0". Cost is \$15.00 per class.

2'0" Hunters

Division fee: \$45.00

Classes 7, 8, 9. Courses to be set as a standard hunter course. No oxers. Fence height at 2'0". Cost is \$15.00 per class.

2'3" Hunters

Division fee: \$60.00

Classes 10, 11, 12. Courses to be set as a standard hunter course. Oxers will be incorporated. Fence height at 2'3". Cost is \$20.00 per class.

2'6" Hunters

Division fee: \$60.00

Classes 13, 14, 15. Courses to be set as a standard hunter course. Oxers will be incorporated. Fence height at 2'6". Cost is \$20.00 per class.

2'9" Hunters

Division fee: \$60.00

Classes 16, 17, 18. Courses to be set as a standard hunter course. Oxers will be incorporated. Fence height at 2'9". Cost is \$20.00 per class.

3'0" Hunters

Division fee: \$60.00

Classes 19, 20, 21. Courses to be set as a standard hunter course. Oxers will be incorporated. Fence height at 3'0". Cost is \$20.00 per class.
